Appointment of the MRCP(UK) International Associate Medical Director

The Federation of the Royal Colleges of Physicians of the UK is seeking to appoint an International Associate Medical Director. This is a new post created to ensure that the MRCP(UK) Diploma and the Specialty Certificate Examinations are developed as International qualifications.

The International Associate Medical Director will have responsibility for building relationships with hosts, organisers who already work with the exams and senior members of the international medical establishment to ensure that the MRCP(UK) Diploma and the Specialty Certificate Examinations set a medical standard throughout the world. The International Associate Medical Director will advise the MRCP(UK) Management Board on its international strategy, and work with the three colleges of the Federation, to build on their existing international relationships.

The person appointed will be a Fellow of one of the Royal Colleges of Physicians of the United Kingdom, practising in a medical specialty and a physician of considerable standing within the medical field. The role will require the individual to undertake international visits in support of the examinations.

Applicants should submit a brief outline of their professional training, together with a resume of their commitment to medical education and training, and their specific expertise in the MRCP(UK) Diploma and Speciality Certificate Examinations. Applications and enquiries to:
