

The Course will cover:

- Introduction to systematic reviews
- Developing a research question
- Planning a literature search
- What to do after the search, including assessing
- Risk of bias and presenting findings
- Introduction to meta-analysis
- Clinical applications (GRADE)

This one day course provides an introduction to the process of systematic review and meta-analysis. You will receive an overview of concepts and methodology, and guidance to support further learning.

It is aimed primarily at early years' medical trainees (IMT2/IMT3/ST4) but suitable for anyone who wants to gain a basic understanding of this area.

You don't need to have research experience or have performed a review as this course will guide you on how to plan and performing a systematic review and interpret published reviews.
