DUNCAN EDWIN PENFOLD FORBES

Dr D.E.P. Forbes died on 22 August 1997. He was born on 31 August 1919 and graduated MB ChB at the University of Edinburgh in 1941. He gained the MD in 1949 and was appointed a consultant chest physician at the West Heath Hospital in Birmingham. He was elected to the Fellowship in 1978.

JAMES HINGSTON

Dr J. Hingston died on 19 December 1997. He was born on 7 January 1921 and graduated MB at the National University of Ireland in 1944. After gaining the MD in 1946, and the DCH in 1947 he worked in paediatrics in England for a few years. In 1954 he emigrated to Canada, later being appointed a clinical professor in the Department of Paediatrics at the University of British Columbia. He became a Fellow in 1971.

RONALD HOUSTON

Dr R. Houston died on 28 February 1998. He was born on 2 February 1923 and graduated MB ChB at the University of Edinburgh in 1946. After service with the RAMC until 1953, he joined Shell International and worked in Indonesia and Nigeria. He became a Member of the Faculty of Occupational Medicine in 1978. From 1976 until his retirement in 1982 he was Chief Medical Officer of Shell UK Ltd. He was awarded the OBE in 1980 and was elected a Fellow in 1977.

THOMAS THEODORE SCOTT INGRAM

Dr T.T.S. Ingram died on 12 February 1998. He was born on 20 August 1927 and graduated MB ChB at the University of Edinburgh in 1949. Dr Ingram had a lifelong interest in paediatrics and was influential in this becoming a specialty following the setting up of the NHS in 1948. He gained the MD with Gold Medal in 1961 at Edinburgh University, and was later appointed Reader in Paediatrics with particular responsibility for paediatric neurology. He was elected a Fellow in 1962.

HAMIDALI MAHBUBALI KHAN

Dr H.M. Khan died on 14 January 1998. He was born on 14 January 1914 and graduated MB at the University of Bombay in 1939. After gaining the DCH in London in 1946 he worked in Karachi. He later established the Department of Paediatrics at Jinnah Postgraduate Medical Centre and was appointed Professor of Paediatrics. He was President of the Pakistan Medical Association from 1962 until 1968. He became a Fellow in 1955.

SAAED AHMED KHAN

Dr S.A. Khan died on 6 December 1996. He was born on 1 November 1936 and graduated MB BS at the University of Karachi in 1961. Dr Khan moved to the United Kingdom and specialised in dermatology. He was appointed a consultant dermatologist in Wakefield in 1971. He was elected a Fellow in 1984.

JAMES MACMASTER MACFIE

Dr J.M. MacFie died on 9 January 1998. He was born on 4 February 1914 and graduated MB ChB at the University of Edinburgh in 1936. After service in the RAMC during World War II he worked in the Birmingham Professorial Unit. For many years he was Emeritus Physician and Area Director for Postgraduate Medical Studies in Nottingham. He became a Fellow in 1947.

JAMES MACWILLIAM MACGREGOR

Dr J.M. MacGregor died on 5 March 1998. He was born in 1911. He gained the Triple Qualification in 1937 and the DPM in London in 1938. From 1940 until 1947 he served with the RAMC in India, Burma and Oxford. He emigrated to South Africa in 1949 and in 1963 he was appointed head of the Department of Neurology at Groote Schuur Hospital and the University of Cape Town. He was elected to the Fellowship in 1974.

RODERICK FRANK MAGGS

Dr R.F. Maggs died on 23 February 1998. He was born on 8 November 1917 and graduated MB ChB at the University of Cape Town in 1941. From 1942 until 1946 he served with the armed forces before coming to Britain. He worked in London and gained the DCH in 1947. After returning to South Africa he was appointed a consultant paediatrician and lecturer at the University of Cape Town in 1950. He was elected a Fellow in 1972.

NILS W. SVENNINGSSEN

Dr N.W. Svenningsen died on 30 January 1998. He was born on 26 May 1934 and gained the MD in 1961 and the PhD in 1974, both in Sweden. Following two years as a research fellow at Hammersmith Hospital in London he specialised in paediatrics. He was appointed Professor of Paediatrics and Neonatal Medicine at the University of Lund in 1986. He became a Fellow in 1997.

ROBERT STUART WELLS

Dr R.S. Wells died on 12 January 1998. He was born on 18 October 1928 and graduated MB BS at the University of London in 1952. He gained the DCH in 1956 and the MD in 1966. He specialised in dermatology and was appointed a consultant to Guy's Hospital, London in 1968. He was elected to the Fellowship in 1969.

DESMOND GILBERT CROMIE WHYTE

Dr D.G.C. Whyte died on 10 February 1998. He was born on 20 September 1913 and graduated MB BCh at Queen's University, Belfast in 1937. He gained the MD in 1951. He served with the armed forces in India and the Middle East from 1939 until 1954, and was awarded the DSO. In 1954 he was appointed a consultant radiologist in Northern Ireland and he became a Fellow of the Royal College of Radiologists in 1975. He was elected a Fellow in 1957.
